WHO THIS IS FOR

County commissions and task forces facing a funding decision.

This session is built for the moment when a county overdose response task force, board of commissioners, or coalition needs to make a real funding decision and the room needs to walk out aligned. It is not a generic overview. It is your county's data, in your county's room, structured around the choices on your agenda.

Sample agenda

9:00 AM	Welcome and where we actually stand <i>A 30-minute data review built from your county's 2024 TDH numbers. Per capita cost, year-over-year change, substance breakdown. No academic framing.</i>
9:30 AM	What is driving the trend <i>Fentanyl saturation, stimulant rise, and the limits of the current treatment system. Tied to interventions that have worked in comparable Tennessee counties.</i>
10:30 AM	Break
10:45 AM	Funding decisions ahead of you <i>A walk through the specific budget items, opioid settlement allocations, or grant decisions on your near-term agenda. Trade-offs made explicit.</i>
12:00 PM	Q&A and next steps <i>Structured discussion with commissioners or task force members. Captured action items delivered as a one-page leave-behind.</i>

WHAT THE FULL ENGAGEMENT INCLUDES

- Pre-session intake call (one hour) with the host to scope audience, decision context, and political constraints.
- Custom slide deck built on your county or region's actual 2024 data, not a generic template.
- Half-day session (three to four hours) delivered in person or via video conference.
- One-page leave-behind summarizing recommendations and captured action items, delivered within five business days.
- Thirty days of follow-up email support for questions that come up after the session.
